Cherry Capital Airport – TVC Has Record Breaking 2021

(Traverse City, MI) – Northwest Regional Airport Authority (NRAA) officials are pleased to announce that passenger traffic during 2021 at TVC – Cherry Capital Airport set a new record. Kevin Klein, CEO of the NRAA released the record setting number of passengers traveling by way of TVC Airport during the NRAA January Regular meeting today.

“Cherry Capital Airport has had an amazing year with an exceptional summer season leading to the record 602,626 total passengers,” Kevin Klein, CEO said during the NRAA meeting.

2021 brought multiple renovations and additions to the airport including a new inline security screening equipment, new fiber for faster free internet, and a new jet bridge. 2022 looks to build an additional 424 auto parking lot spaces along with the expansion a new 40,000 – gallon jet fuel storage tanks. These renovations and new parking lot will help improve the customer commitment by providing the amenities our customer desire.

2019 provided the previous record with 579,712 passengers. Our airline partners together in 2021 provided non-stop flights to and from 17 destinations for an overall increase of 4% in passengers.
