

## Expanded TSA Checkpoint

The Cherry Capital Airport worked with TSA to expand the Security Checkpoint from 2 lanes to 3 lanes and upgraded checkpoint technology for \$3.2 million. Enhancements include touchless credential authentication technology (CAT) machines, that validate that it's both a real ID and that the person is booked to fly out that day. The project is noteworthy in that it 1) utilized the same physical space (no building footprint changes), and 2) had the project concept initiated on March 10, 2022, and completed by May 26, 2022. This means the project - from conception to completion - was only 78 days. Project required moving over 90' long of a 7' high glass partition wall and installation of all new power and communications during overnight shifts to still allow for daytime checkpoint usage. Concrete floor removal and replacement was done by hand.
