

## **Job Title: Full-Time Airport Maintainers**

Job Summary: Performs difficult skilled trades work ensuring operational and safety compliance activities, providing equipment and automotive maintenance and repair, while assisting in the maintenance of airport grounds, facilities and related work as assigned. Work performed under the supervision of the Airport Operations Manager.

Working shifts of up to 10 hours or more at a time, working holidays on occasion and working weekends.

Employee is responsible for the purchase of their own tools to be used on Airport Equipment. Such tools should be kept in Employee provided toolbox for safe keeping.

Candidate must have a high school diploma or GED.

1-3 years' experience in equipment and automotive maintenance and repair is recommended. Recent experience in an airport environment is desirable.

Possess a combination or all of the following ASE Certifications or equivalent experience.

A Series, Automobile, and Light Truck Certification.

E Series, Truck equipment certification.

G1, Auto Maintenance and Light repair Certification.

L2, Electronic Diesel Engine diagnosis specialist certification.

T Series, Medium-Heavy Truck certification.

Current Valid driver's license. Class A Commercial driver's license within 6 months of hire.

Successful candidate must pass a pre-employment physical including chest/back x-rays and drug/alcohol screens. Candidate must also pass a criminal history records check.

Satisfactory driving record is a must in order for the Airport's insurance company to accept candidate as an approved driver of the Airport's equipment and vehicles.
